Armstrong Road – Proposed Parking Restrictions

Littlemore Parish Council welcomes this proposals to insert double yellow lines at location stated, but it is concerned about the impact it will have on cars parking on grass verges outside Littlemore Hospital and would ask the department to consider placing double yellow line here to stop cars blocking cycle paths and ruining verges.

Oxford Road – Proposed Traffic Calming Measures

St. Nicholas Road – Parking Scheme

In general, the scheme was welcomed but two points of concerns was raised.
