

Significant Variation between Accounting Statements for 2021-22 and 2022-23: Box 3 – Other receipts

2021-22: £9,043

2022-23: £85,508

Change: 846% increase

The difference of £76,465 was mainly the result of one main factor, an enormous increase of £77,389 in the amount the Council received from Oxford City Council by way of Community Infrastructure Levy.

In 2021-22 the Council received just £869 by way of Community Infrastructure Levy, whereas in 2022-23 it received £78,258.

It should be acknowledged that Community Infrastructure Levy receipts are inherently likely to vary sharply between financial years as they depend on the activity of developers. For comparison, the Council received £129,005 in 2020-21 by way of Community Infrastructure Levy.
